Your Dreams, Our Commitment Now with Greater **Scholarship Support**

We are delighted to share that our scholarship program has been significantly strengthened to provide enhanced support to meritorious and economically underprivileged students aspiring to become Chartered Accountants. Effective immediately, the Council has approved revisions to the Scholarship Guidelines, increasing financial aid across several key categories. The monthly scholarship for CA Intermediate rank holders (1st to 10th) has been increased from ₹2,500 to ₹5,000, while students ranked 11th to 50th, with a parental income of up to ₹5 lakh per annum, will now receive ₹4,000 per month, up from ₹2,000. For economically disadvantaged students pursuing Intermediate and Final courses, the monthly scholarship amount has been raised from ₹1,500 to ₹2,500. Additionally, a new scholarship of ₹1,500 for four months has been introduced for Foundation Course students from economically weaker backgrounds.
